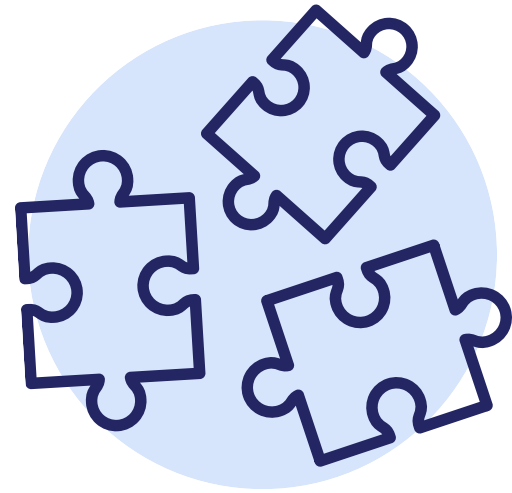


R.E.A.L.[®] Discussion Skills
